



# MANOR HOUSE HEALTH AND SAFETY

## Basic Life Support for the Newborn

<b>Course Duration</b>	To be agreed, but normally one and a half – two hours.
<b>Who will Benefit</b>	New mothers, anyone dealing with newborns. Mother and baby, mother and toddler groups. Nursery nurses. Health care professionals.
<b>Relevant Legislation</b>	The Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999
<b>Course Objectives</b>	To ensure that the delegate has relevant knowledge to deal with choking of newborn, cardiac arrest of newborn, to be able to identify and deal with said situation and administer first line intervention until help arrives.
<b>Maximum Number of Delegates</b>	Normally 12 with single trainer. A second trainer would be required for more delegates

Premises need to have comfortable seating for all delegates, room for practical element, hygiene facilities and a mains electricity supply.
