<b>Course Duration</b>	Half Day – to be run in conjunction with another short course.
<b>Who will Benefit</b>	Anyone dealing with catheter use. Staff in Nursing/care homes. Family members caring for relatives in the community.
<b>Relevant Legislation</b>	The Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999 Personal Protective Equipment at Work Regulations 1992 Control Of Substances Hazardous to Health 2002
<b>Course Objectives</b>	To ensure that delegates have a thorough knowledge of indwelling urinary catheters. The dangers of infection, prevention of same and care of the catheter. Signs and symptoms of problems with catheterization.
<b>Maximum Number of Delegates</b>	14 depending on room size.

Premises need to have comfortable seating for all delegates, and a mains electricity supply.
