## POVA (Protection of Vulnerable Adults)

<b>Course Duration</b>	Full Day and Half Day Refresher courses
<b>Who will Benefit</b>	Workers who provide personal care to adults in various care settings i.e. hospital, residential or in client's own home and who need to understand more fully their role and responsibilities in preventing the abuse of vulnerable adults
<b>Relevant Legislation</b>	The Care Standards Act 2000 The Police Act 1997 (Enhanced Criminal Record Certificates) (Protection of Vulnerable Adults) Regulations 2002 No Secrets 2000
<b>Course Objectives</b>	To examine the forms and indicators of abuse. To recognise abusive behaviour and actions. Define Vulnerable Adult To increase awareness on how to prevent or minimise potential abuse. Whistleblowing and how to report suspected abusive actions including confidential disclosure.
